## RULES GOVERNING THE SADDLE CLUB GROUNDS

1. All guests must sign a Liability Waiver, which are located in the kiosk on the announcers' booth. Place completed waivers in the mailbox by the kiosk.
2. Children under the age of 18 must be supervised at all times by a parent, legal guardian or a responsible adult with some actual authority over the minor.
3. The arena, round pen, cross-country jump course, trail course, and stalls are for members' and pre-scheduled event participants' use only, and are open for members' use except during pre-scheduled events. Out of town travelers with horses may camp on the grounds and use the stalls for overnight rest only.
4. No unattended horses in the arena or round pen.
5. Remove all jumps and barrels from the arena before leaving.
6. Close and latch all gates after use of arena, round pen, or stalls.
7. If using the stalls, leave them clean and ready for the next use.
8. Put manure, hay, etc in designated area by the west end of the stalls.
9. Tie animals to the tie posts at the north and south ends of the arena. Do not tie to the arena, stall, or round pen rails.
10. Dogs are allowed but need to be under control at all times.
